- If you need immediate urgent assistance, **please call 911.**
- Should you require temporary accommodations, please contact the Municipal Office.

For safety reasons, remember to turn off your hydro prior to leaving. Also, your drinking water could be contaminated.

Some roads are currently CLOSED. We ask for folks to respect the signs and not travel down any roads when not necessary. Should your road become **inaccessible**, please contact the Municipal Office ASAP. Residents are advised that emergency vehicles will not be able to access roads that are closed due to flooding.

Everybody is working very hard. **We ask people to remain patient, as we are all trying to work together.**

Sand bags will continue to be available for all municipalities at the Allumettes Municipal Garage (450 Rang 5). More bags have been ordered, but resources are depleting and we ask that folks be respectful of everyone's needs and requests. Volunteers are always welcome
