<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Newspaper • Coated paper (circulars, magazines) • Office paper • Kraft paper (brown bags) • Envelopes with or without plastic window • Corrugated cardboard (heavy cardboard) (maximum dimensions: 1 metre x 0,5 metre) • Boxboard and corrugated cardboard (cereal boxes, pizza boxes, etc.) • Moulded pulp (egg containers, etc.) • Milk cartons, juice cartons, and frozen food boxes • Aluminium lined juice cartons (Tetra-Pak) • Lid-free containers and bottles • Plastic types 1 through 7 with the exception of refused plastic materials (see column on the right) • Food product containers (margarine, yogurt, ice cream, muffins, etc.) • Maintenance product containers (dishwashing liquid, bleach, etc.) • Cosmetic product containers (shampoo, cream, etc.) • Plastic lids • Grocery and produce bags • Bread and milk bags, empty and clean • Plastic toys free of <i>any</i> metal parts • Earth-free plastic gardening pots • Compact discs, DVDs, and cases • Tin cans (with or without labels) • Caps or lids • Aluminium beverage cans • Clean aluminium paper or plates 	<p style="text-align: center;">Paper</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Carbon paper • Tissue paper and paper towels • Waxed paper • Food contaminated paper, oil soaked paper, etc. • Potato bags <p style="text-align: center;">Cardboard</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oil-soaked cardboard, paint-soaked cardboard, etc. <p style="text-align: center;">Glass</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tableware • Windows or mirrors • Light bulbs and fluorescent lamps • Fibre glass • Porcelain and ceramic • Pyrex <p style="text-align: center;">Plastic</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plastic film (<i>e.g.</i>, <i>Saran Wrap</i>) • Containers or pieces of Styrofoam • Containers for motor oil, turpentine, gasoline, or any other dangerous goods • Biomedical products (syringes, needles, etc.) • Chip bags • Hay baling bags • Styrofoam gardening pots • Garden hose • Rope (nylon, clothes line, hay baling, etc.) • Vinyl lap joint <p style="text-align: center;">Metal</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All types of batteries • Paint, stripper or aerosol containers • Propane tanks • Metal pieces of over 2 kg and longer than 60 cm • Metal coat hangers and wire

NOTE: ALL KIND OF CONSTRUCTION WASTE ARE REFUSED (CARPET, TOILET, BATH TUB, WOOD, VINYL, SHINGLES, TILES, CERAMIC ETC)

Instructions :

- The plastic bags must be gathered and compressed in the same bag.
- Ideally, the plastic caps must remain on the plastic containers.
- It is not necessary to remove the plastic neck from the milk, juice, and Tetra Pak type containers.
- All containers must be rinsed out.
- Labels can be left on tin cans and glass containers.
- Residual food must be removed from pizza boxes and other restaurant delivery boxes.
